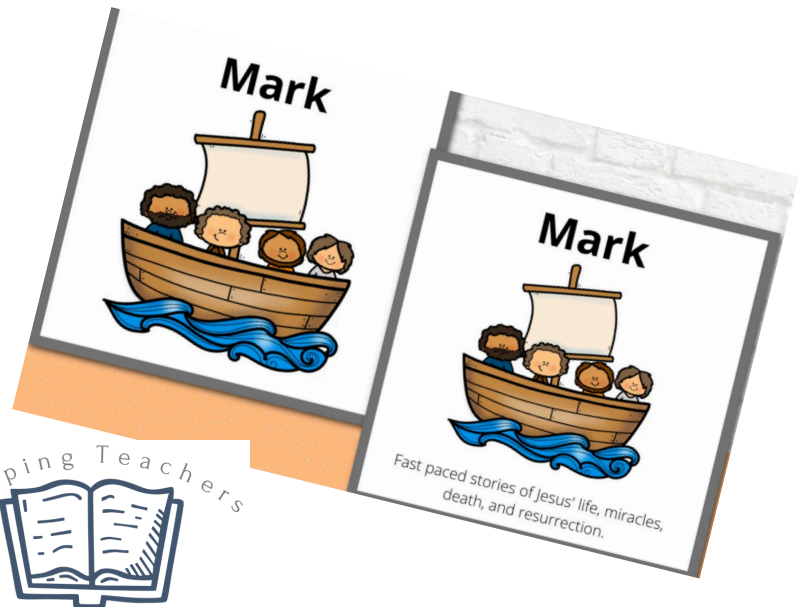
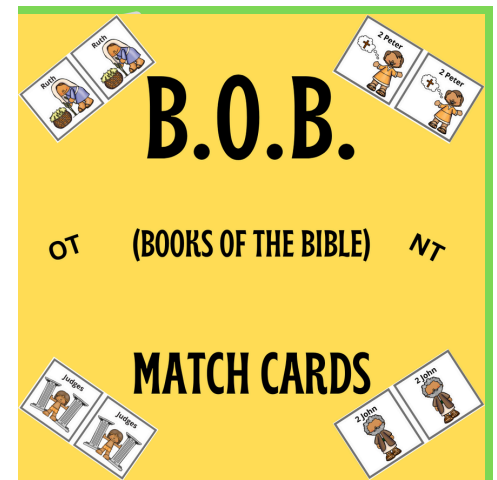

HOW TO PLAY

- PLACE ALL CARDS FACE DOWN ON TABLE IN A GRID
- KIDS CAN PLAY ALONE OR WITH A FRIEND TO MAKE IT EASIER
- HAVE KIDS TAKE TURNS TURNING OVER CARDS TO FIND MATCHES
- HAVE KIDS CALL OUT THE NAMES OF THE BOOKS AS THEY TURN THE CARDS
- WHEN A MATCH IS MADE, THAT KID GETS ANOTHER TURN
- WHEN ALL MATCHES ARE MADE - HAVE KIDS COUNT THEIR MATCHES TO DETERMINE A WINNER
- HAVE SMALL PRIZE/STICKERS FOR WINNERS
- FOR OLDER KIDS HAVE THEM READ THE INFORMATION ABOUT THAT BOOK WHEN THEY MAKE A MATCH

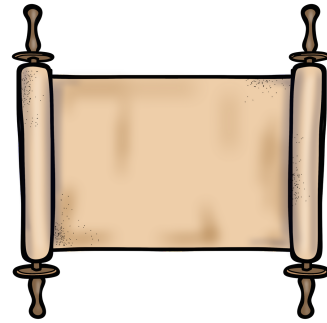


Through Moses, God gave instructions to His people, the Israelites, on how to worship Him and live a holy life.

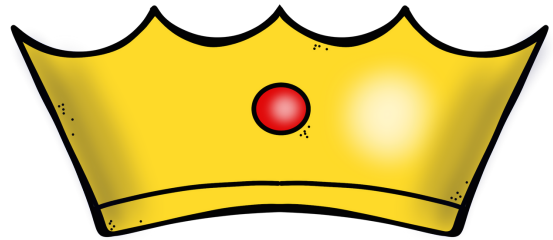


The stories of Samuel, King Saul, and King David, including the story of David and Goliath

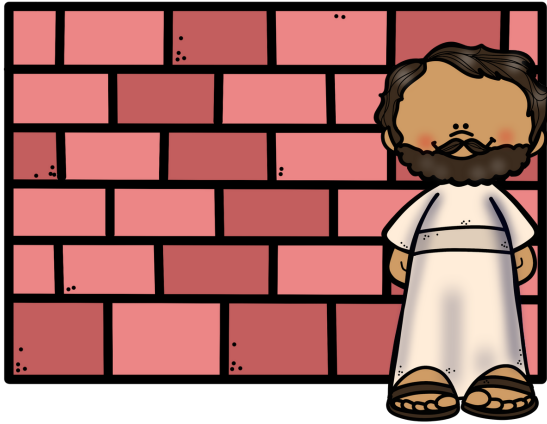

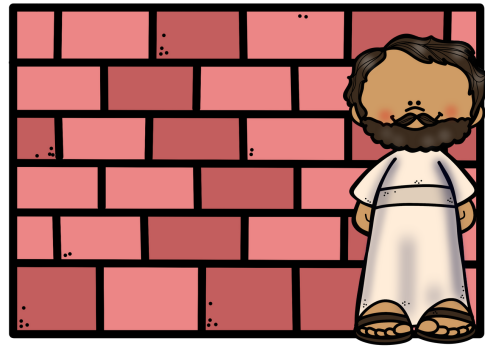


After the Babylonian captivity, God used men who followed Him, including Ezra, to lead the Jews back to Judah, rebuild the temple, and teach the people God's laws.

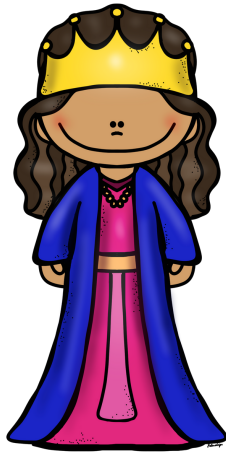

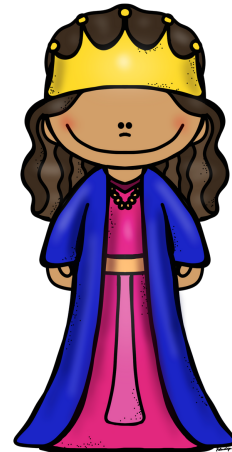


God called Nehemiah to rebuild the wall around Jerusalem so the Jews would be safe from their enemies.

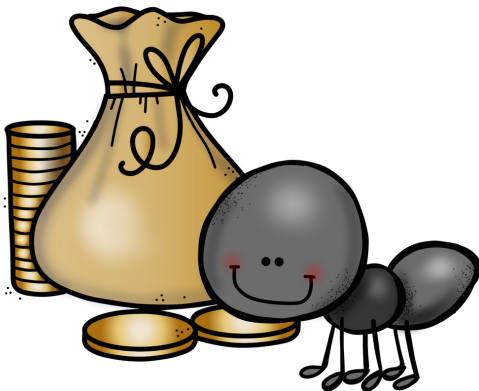

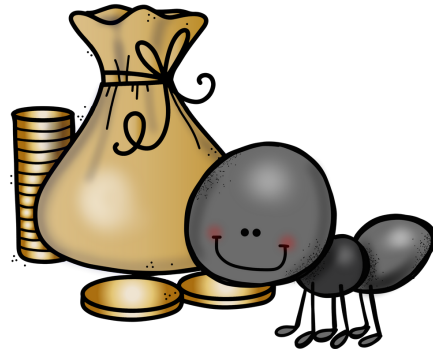


A book of poems and prayers to God that help us to pray and worship God no matter what is going on or what we are feeling. Psalms reminds us that God is always in control.

This book is a love song between two married people and shows us that God delights in married love.

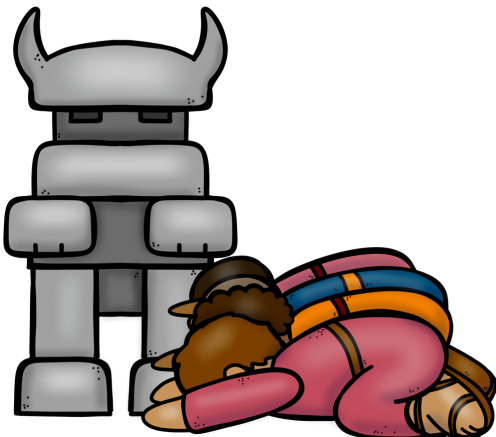

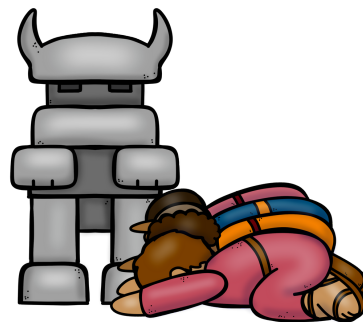
The prophet Isaiah warned the people of Judah to turn away from their sin and turn back to God or they would come under God's judgment.

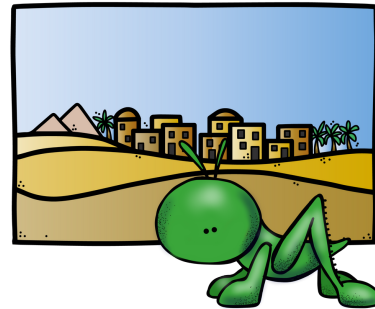


God used His prophet Hosea to show Israel that God would judge them if they didn't repent of their sins, but that God also still loved them.

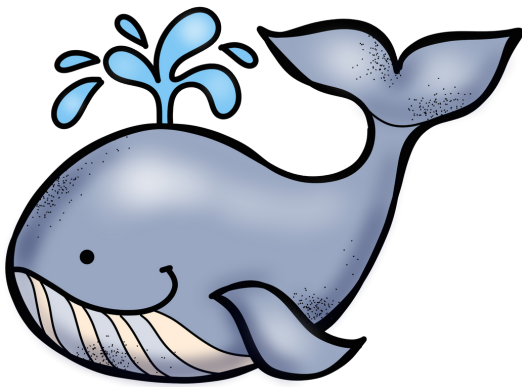

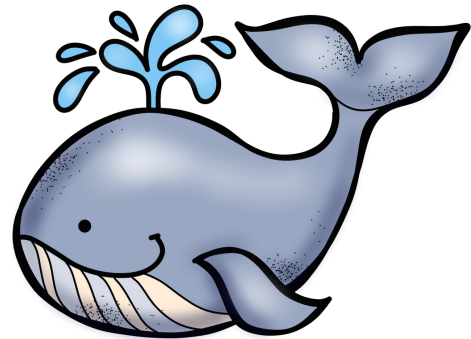


The Edomites had been fighting against Israel for 100's of years. God tells the Edomites that they will be destroyed because of their violence against Israel.

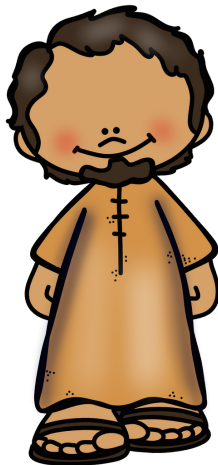

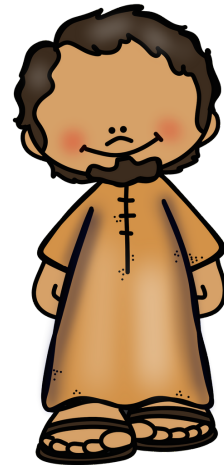


Nahum warns the Assyrians of God's coming judgment on Nineveh.

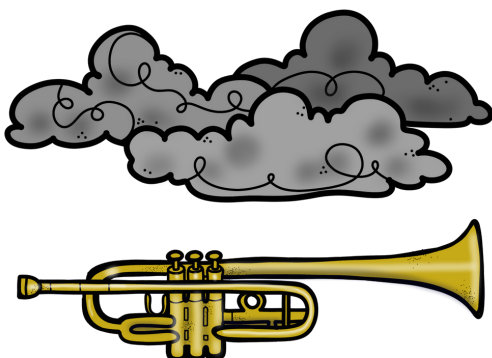

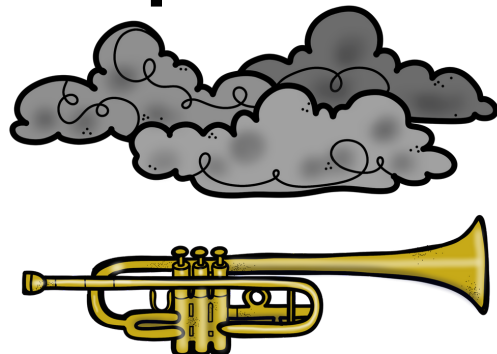


The prophet Habakkuk learned to trust and worship God, even when life seemed unfair and those who did evil seemed to go unpunished.

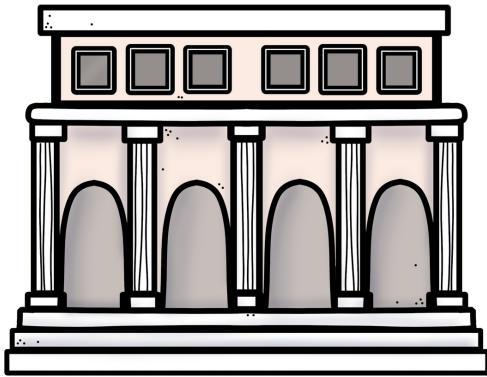

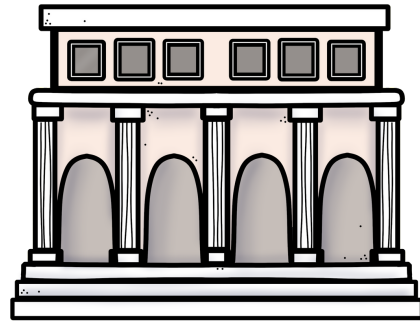


Zephaniah prophesied that God would judge the Jews at the hand of Nebuchadnezzar and all people later at the "Day of the Lord."

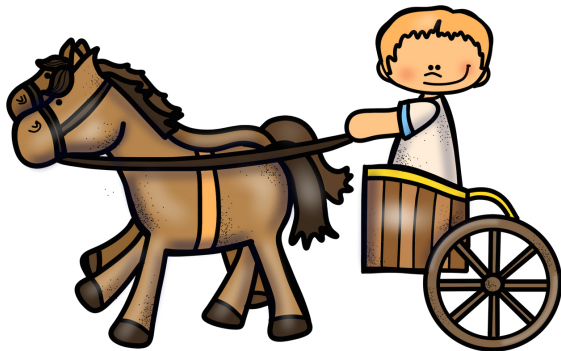

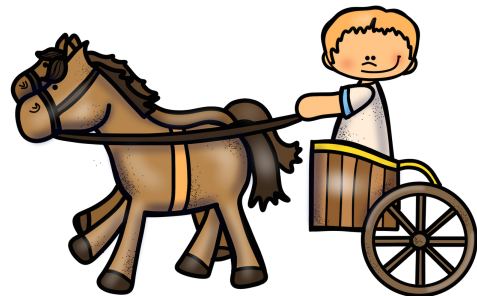


God called Haggai (together with Zechariah) to urge the people to continue rebuilding the temple and to put God first in their lives.

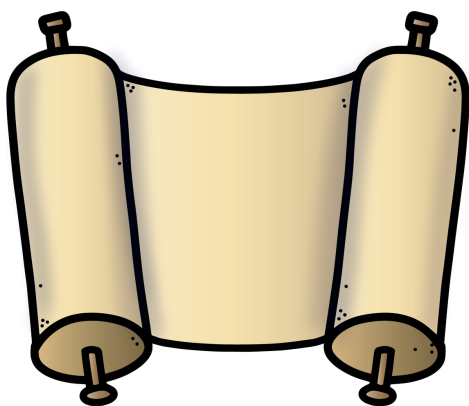

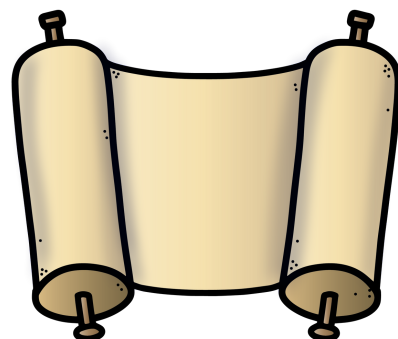


God called Zechariah (together with Haggai) to urge the people to continue rebuilding the temple. Zechariah reminds the people of God's coming promised Savior, the Messiah.

Malachi

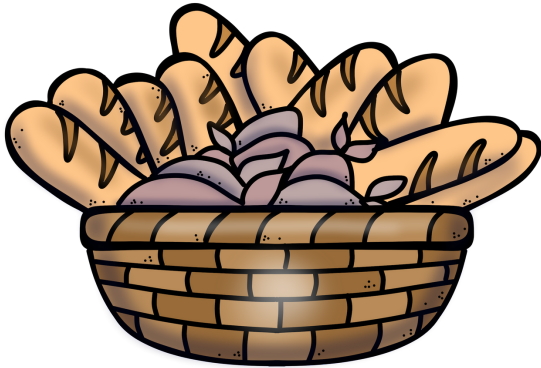


Malachi

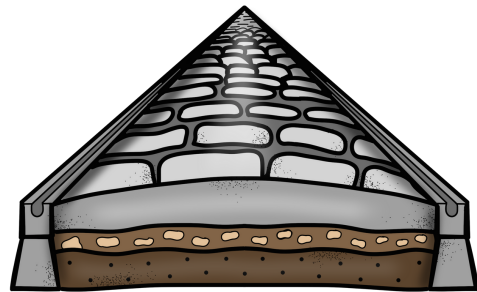


A letter Paul wrote to help the Ephesian Christians know how to live in faith, unity, and love toward one another.

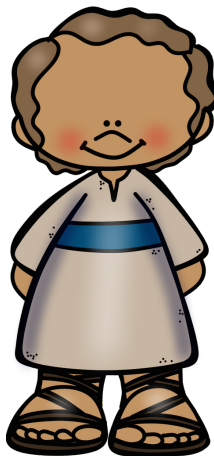

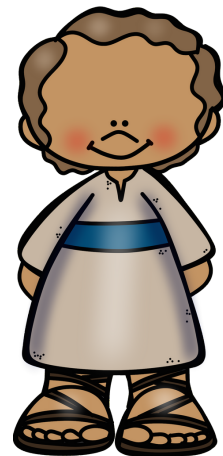
Paul was in prison in Rome and knew that he would soon die. He wrote to encourage his young friend, Pastor Timothy, to continue preaching God's Word.

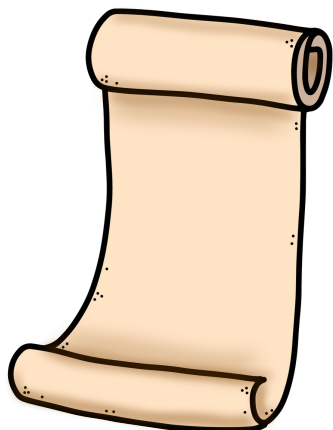

Paul wrote this letter to a young pastor named Titus, encouraging him to be a good leader and teacher.

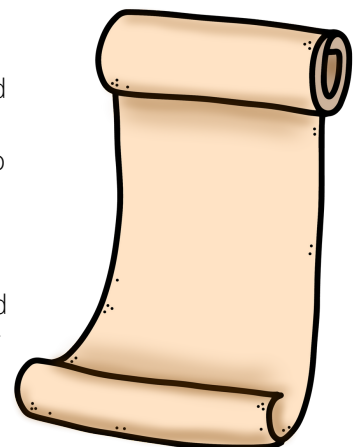

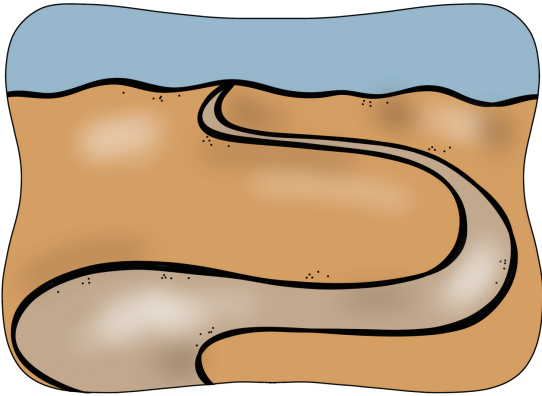

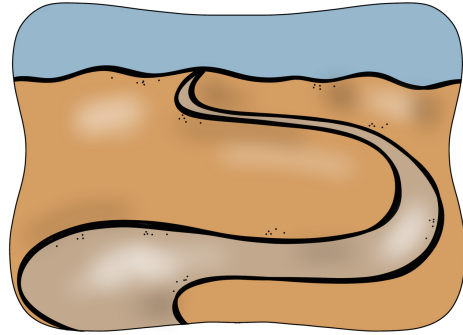
Paul wrote this letter to his friend Philemon to encourage him to welcome his runaway slave, Onesimus, back with kindness and love as a brother in Christ.

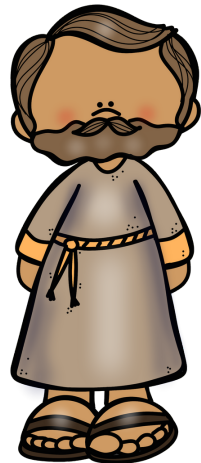

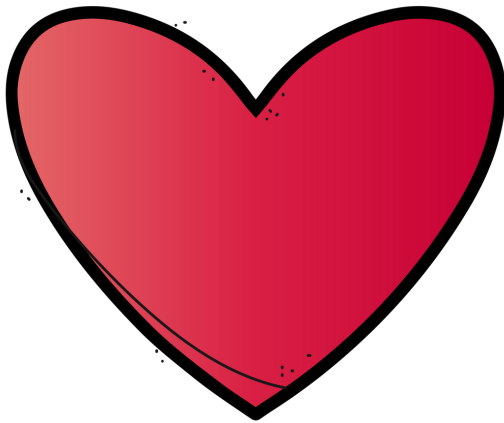

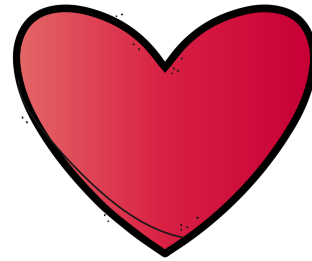


A letter that Peter, who knew that he would soon die, wrote to Christians everywhere to encourage them to continue in the truth of the Gospel and refuse false teachers.

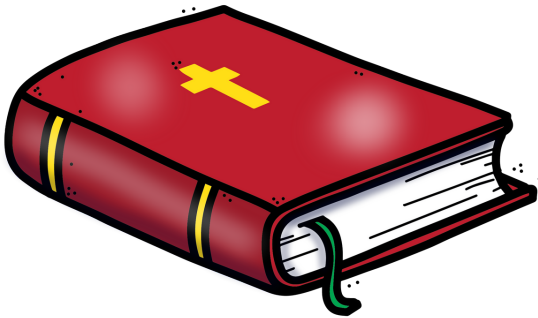

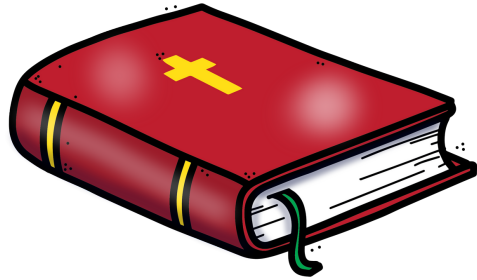


A letter that John wrote to encourage a Christian woman to obey God and be careful of people who would lead her away from Jesus.

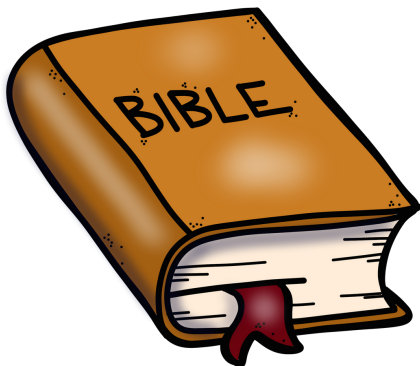

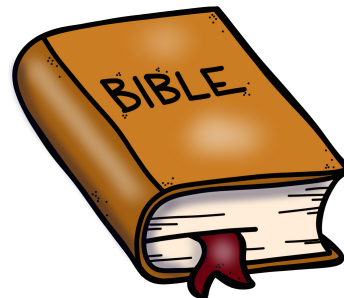


A letter that John wrote to his friend, Gaius, thanking him for showing hospitality to traveling missionaries and encouraging him to continue walking in God's truth.

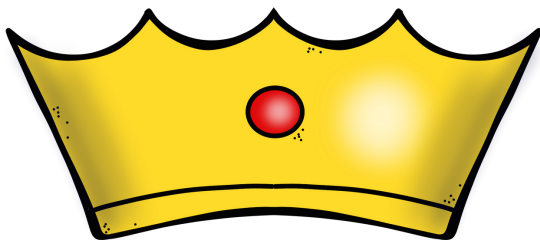

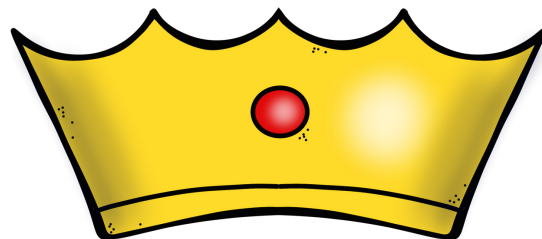


Jude wrote this short, fiery book to warn Christians not to accept false teachers or ideas that go against the truth of the Bible.
