
- PLACE ALL CARDS FACR DOWN ON TABLE IN A GRID

- HAVE KIDS TAKE TURNS TURNING OVER CARDS TO FIND MATCHES




- HAVE KIDS CALL OUT THE NAMES OF THE BOOKS AS THEY TURN THE CARDS

- FOR OLDER KIDS HAVE THEM READ THE INFORMATION ABOUT THAT BOOK WHEN THEY MAKE A MATCH


















A wise book that reminds us that without God, everything in this life is pointless and empty (vanity). With God, our lives have purpose, meaning, and hope.








Lamentations

During the Babylonian captivity, the prophet Ezekiel urged the Jews to repent of their sins and seek God. This book includes the "vision of the dry bones."



Jonah refused to give God's message to the Ninevites and spent three days in a fish before being vomited up and obeying God.







Micah warned Judah of God's coming judgment because they refused to deal justly with the poor and obey God's laws.












God called Haggai (together with Zechariah) to urge the people to continue rebuilding the temple and to put God first in their lives.


Zechariah



God called Zechariah (together with Haggai) to urge the people to continue rebuilding the temple. Zechariah reminds the people of God's coming promised Savior, the Messiah.










Malachi urged the people to repent of their sins, to turn their hearts to God, and to remember that God's Messiah was coming.








































A letter Paul wrote to encourage the Philippian Christians and remind them that they could find joy, even in the midst of the suffering they were experiencing.





A letter Paul wrote from a Roman prison to remind the Colossian Christians that Jesus Christ has fully and completely guaranteed our salvation. He is Lord over all.


